2023 Veterans Day Parade Rules and Regulations

Our Goal is to create a safe and fun event for everyone who participates in the parade, entries and spectators alike. Please review the following Parade Rules and Regulations prior to submitting your parade entry. All entries are required to sign this sheet specifying that these rules have been reviewed and understood.

All Participants Must:

- Display patriotism and an American Flag.
- > Check in as a group no later than 8:30 am at North Entrance of CCCC, near Smoothy King. Do not use front entrances or Country Club road entrance, as they will be blocked off.
- > Be respectful in attitude and vocabulary.
- All animal waste must be properly cleaned up and disposed.
- > All animals must be leashed at all times.
- Check in with assigned parking lot Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter NC-5 member for line up position and any other necessary requests.

Good To Know:

- ✓ Restrooms available in Math and Science Building.
- ✓ CCCC is now a tobacco free campus (cigars, cigarettes, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes.)
- ✓ If questions or concerns, seek Rolling Thunder®, Inc. members. In case of emergency CCCC security personnel and JPD will be present.
- ✓ The Salvation Army will have beverages and snacks for donations. Please support them.
- ✓ Organizations may share business cards and fliers with other participants. No selling of any items on CCCC or along the parade route.

Participants Along Parade Route:

- All JPD rules must be adhered. Drivers must have licenses and all vehicles in safe working order. JPD will be along route in case of emergency.
- ➤ Vehicles are asked to stay near center of road. No stunt or reckless driving. JPD will remove deemed unsafe vehicles during parade.
- Motorcyclists do not have to wear helmets along parade route. Helmets must be worn at all other times.
- No political campaigning.
- No vocabulary, materials, or gestures which could be offensive.
- Do not encourage audience to come into roadway or onto any vehicle while parade is moving.
- Be enthusiastic and engage the audience.
- No horns or sirens in front of hospital. Also NO Boom Boxes allowed on top of vehicles during parade.
- Media and Announcers near JOEMC. Acceptable to slow pace but do not stop for more than 1 minute.
- Refrain from being on the phone or other electronic devices.
- No throwing items (candy, fliers, etc). Walking beside vehicle and handing out acceptable. Be respectful of parents' wishes.
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages.
- Animal waste must be immediately and properly cleaned up.

Decorated Trailers:

- ✓ To be considered, a decorated trailer must be pulled by another vehicle.
- ✓ Decorated trailers will be judged along route for style, enthusiasm, and patriotic theme.
